The exhibit is free and open to the public.



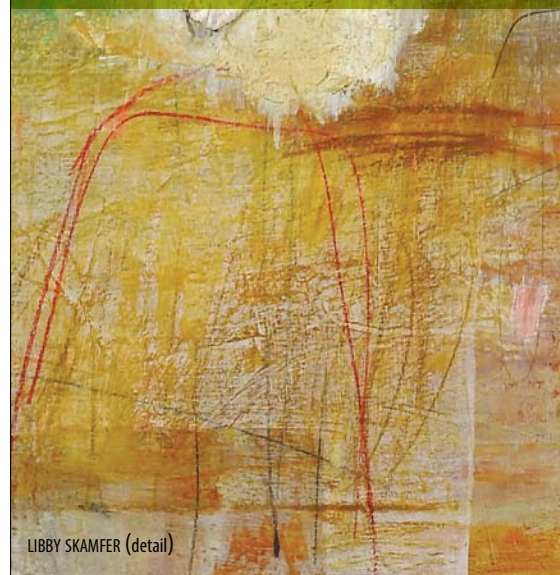
