

City of North Charleston, SC, Features Works by Alice Colin and Elizabeth Northcut Williams

The City of North Charleston, SC, will present *Holding It Together* , featuring a joint exhibition of mixed media works by Alice Colin (Mount Pleasant, SC) and oil paintings by Elizabeth Northcut Williams (North Charleston, SC), on view at the Park Circle Gallery, from Mar. 5 - 29, 2025. A reception will be held on Mar. 7, from 5-7pm.

Holding It Together is an evocative exhibition presented by artists Alice Colin and Elizabeth Northcut Williams exploring the intricate themes of ancestry and identity. Through their unique artistic lenses, both artists delve into personal and collective histories, creating a powerful dialogue that highlights the bonds between past and present.

By intertwining various mediums and techniques, Colin and Williams invite viewers to reflect on their own heritages and the complexities of self-identification in a rapidly changing world. This exhibit promises to be a thought-provoking journey, urging audiences to consider how our roots shape who we are and how we connect with one another across generations.

A self-taught artist, Colin currently works from her studio at Redux Contemporary Art Center in downtown Charleston and was a Visiting Artist at the Gibbes Museum of Art in late 2024.

Elizabeth ("Beth") Northcutt Williams is the current Visiting Artist at the Gibbes Museum of Art. Her diverse body of work can be found in collections all over the country. Since receiving her BFA in painting from the University of Evansville, she has developed a wide range of techniques in oil painting, watercolor, drawing, and mixed media.

Creating everything from portraits to murals, Williams loves to translate ideas into meaningful visual expression, often combining traditional techniques with more contemporary, expressive applications. Inspired by beauty and redemption, she is forever grateful to honor the significance of her subjects.

The Park Circle Gallery is located on Jenkins Avenue in North Charleston. Admission is free and free street parking is available on Jenkins Avenue in front of the gallery, as well as on the adjacent streets and in parking lots close by.

Those early lessons fueled a passion, and by middle school, Keadle was displaying and selling her own paintings alongside her aunt's on a clothesline at Pawleys. These formative years instilled in her a deep appreciation for both nature and art, shaping her creative vision.

Keadle's paintings, deeply rooted in her love for the Lowcountry, evoke a sense of serenity and nostalgia. Her ability to capture the interplay of light and color in natural



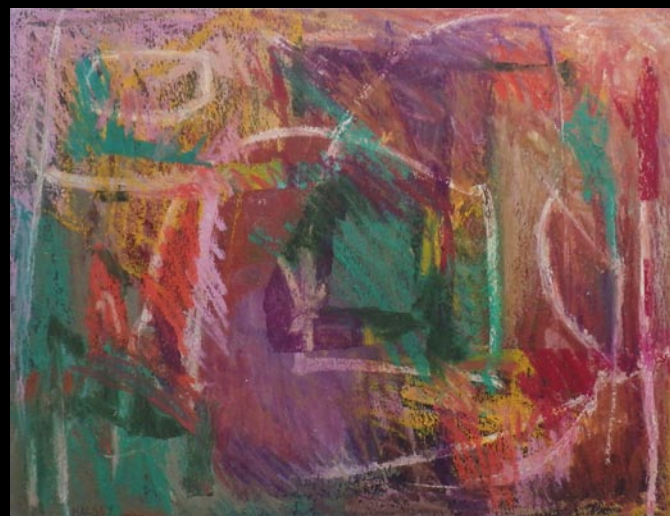
